Winners of the above class are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

**BEST OF BREED**

**(No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete)**

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

**Stud Dog Class:** For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog needs not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one dog or bitch making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

**Brood Bitch Class:** For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the brood bitch needs not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one dog or bitch making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her get and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

**Brace Class:** For two Cavalier King Charles Spaniels (a unit), irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and shown in the ring with no more than two handlers. Dogs may be entered in another class or for brace class only. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the entry form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the entry form.

**SPECIAL AWARDS**

**Best Bred By Exhibitor:** Best Bred By Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred By Exhibitor Class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit Competition. Only dogs not defeated in the Bred By Class are eligible to compete.

**Best Veteran Competition:** Following the conclusion of Best of Breed and the Judge's Awards of Merit, the undefeated winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch classes will compete for Best Veteran.

**Award of Merit:** At the conclusion of the Specialty Show, after picking Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex, the Specialty Judge, at her discretion, may award Rosettes for Judge's Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. **Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier. Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC. PLEASE NOTE: ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN AKC NUMBER prior to the day of the event. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, call (919) 816-3776. Junior Handlers must put their nine-digit number on the entry blank. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form. ## FUTURITY RULES FUTURITY STAKES PURPOSE

The purpose of the Futurity Stakes is to encourage the breeding of the best possible Cavalier King Charles Spaniels and to reward the breeders for their efforts. The Futurity Stakes, which will be held annually in conjunction with our Annual Specialty Show, is entered by nominating a bitch, and then her litter. Individual puppies from a nominated litter are eligible to compete in any Annual Futurity, as long as the nominated puppies are between six and eighteen months of age on the date of the Futurity. If any puppies qualify for more than one Futurity, they must be entered separately in each Futurity. There will be cash awards for each class in the Futurity, and a breakdown of those awards is attached.

### ELIGIBILITY

Bitch, litter, and individual puppy nominations to the Futurity are open only to breeders who are active members, in good standing, of the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Central Arizona, Inc. Any bitch, litter, or individual puppy that is nominated must be owned, co-owned, or leased by a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Central Arizona, Inc. member who has attended at least two club events in the 12-month period prior to the Futurity Stakes. This requirement does not apply to the owner(s) or co-owner(s) of the sire of the nominated litter. To be eligible to compete in any Annual Futurity, a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel puppy must meet the following requirements:

1. Puppy must be from a litter in which the bitch and her resulting litter were properly and timely nominated by the breeder.
2. Puppy must have been individually nominated prior to reaching five months of age by the breeder, even if the breeder is no longer the owner.
3. Puppy may not be out of a bitch, or by a sire, that was owned or co-owned, by the judge in the Futurity Stakes that the puppy will be entered.

### PROCEDURE

1. The breeder must nominate a bitch at least one week (7 days) prior to her whelping.
2. The breeder must nominate a litter prior to the litter reaching 3 months of age.
3. Individual puppies from properly nominated litters must be nominated before reaching 5 months of age. Microchip numbers must be recorded on the nomination.
4. Classes will be divided by sex and age: 6-9 mos, 9-12 mos, 12-15 mos, 15-18 mos. Futurity Stakes class winners will compete for Best in Futurity (BIF) and Best of Opposite Sex (BOS) to Best in Futurity.
5. Postmark on envelope transmitting nomination (or date handwritten by futurity secretary if hand-delivered) establishes date of nomination. Stake entry must be received by the regular show closing date. There will be no refunds.
6. Transfer of ownership does not affect nomination status.
7. No professional handlers may be used unless they are the breeder and owner of the exhibited puppy, and are a member of the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Central Arizona, Inc.
8. If more than one puppy from a breeder is being shown, that breeder may ask another club member to show additional puppies, if necessary.
9. All entries will remain confidential in the care of the Futurity Secretary.

### PRIZE MONIES

All monies from nominations and entry fees (less 35% withheld for CKCSCCA expenses) will be divided as follows:

BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX	5%
ALLOCATED TO CLASSES WITH ENTRIES	60%

(Any unclaimed monies will revert back to the club)							

### NOMINATION FEES

Regular show entry fees will apply. There will be no refunds.

### EXCEPTIONS TO RULES FOR THE 2010 & 2011 FUTURITY STAKES ONLY

The following rules will apply to the 2010 & 2011 Futurity Specialty Shows only. Rules applying to membership requirements will be the same. All nomination fees will be the same.

1. For any already-whelped puppy that will meet the requirements for being 6-18 months of age on our 2010 & 2011 futurity show dates, an open registration period will be held to accept the necessary bitch, litter, and individual puppy nomination forms (and regular fees).
2. All 3 nomination forms must be filled out appropriately and all fees paid. All registrations must be turned in by September 30th – the normal late registration/grace periods and fees do not apply during the open registration period. As of October 1, 2009, all regular registration procedures apply.
3. All puppies must be nominated by the breeder, whether the breeder is the current owner or not.

The above special rules are designed to enable us to have puppies eligible to be shown in all of our classes when we have our 2010 & 2011 Futurities by having an open registration period through September 2009, so plan accordingly. These special rules will expire on September 30, 2009. Any puppies not nominated by this date must be nominated by the regular Futurity rules and procedures.

There is a \$4.00 fee for any entry cancellations.

**A Recording Fee of .50 cents and a Service Fee of \$3.00, \$3.00 Rally Fee** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards**, do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretaries will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** This club and it's Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**During the hours of judging** owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready for judging. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dogs presence is needed in the judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler to bring his dog into the ring.

**Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Secretaries Office advised at once. The Secretaries and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**Trophies and Prizes** will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of judging, any discrepancies must be reported to the Secretary prior to completion of judging. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**Dogs which according** to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.

**Junior Handlers** who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest Conformation judging or one half hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

**Please DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Show Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against the show giving clubs or their members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. **THIS IS A SELF CLEANING SHOW, PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.**

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 3, 2010. Dogs must be removed immediately following Best in Show judging on Monday, March 8, 2010.

**DAY OF SHOW PARKING:** Day of Show Parking fees are at the discretion of West World and are collected at the gate upon arrival. The fee for each automobile space occupied is \$5 per day per entrance. Vehicles occupying more than one space will be charged and located accordingly. A WEEKEND PASS is available for \$20 which offers IN & OUT PRIVILEGES (vehicles occupying more than one space will be charged accordingly). WEEKEND PASSES ARE AVAILABLE IN ADVANCE ONLINE AT [WWW.FIESTAPCLUSTER.COM/PARKING](http://WWW.FIESTAPCLUSTER.COM/PARKING) Parking attendants will direct exhibitors to park in the designated areas on asphalt & gravel parking lots. NO PARKING OR DRIVING ON THE GRASS. Unloading zone will be provided with a 10-minute time limit. You may NOT take your dogs and equipment to the ring and you may NOT take vehicles on the show grounds. You must unload and immediately park your vehicle. There will be NO REGULAR EXHIBITOR PARKING in RESERVED AREAS or any area designated as an OFFICIAL FIRE ZONE or NO PARKING ZONE. There will be limited handicap day of show parking which will be available on a "first come" basis. Exhibitors not abiding by the rules may be subject to a Show Committee Hearing and have their vehicles towed out of the area or ticketed.

**GENERATORS & MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Power for grooming tents and setups will be provided by the Fiesta Cluster. NO OTHER PORTABLE GENERATORS will be allowed on the polo field. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES shall be operated in the aisles between rings or within 20 feet of any ring.

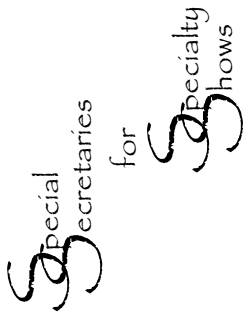
**FIESTA CLUSTER GROOMING & SETUPS:** Public Grooming tents and set up areas will be designated by the Fiesta Cluster. The grooming and crating area will be supervised by the members of Fiesta Cluster Committee who will be available to assist in and enforce the setup starting **Wednesday, March 4, 2010 at 1pm. Public Grooming Tents** with power are provided for the use of exhibitors on a first come, first served basis. Exhibitors are not permitted to mark off or reserve space in the public grooming tents with roping, cones, etc. Exercise pens are not permitted under Public Grooming Tents. Aisles will be designated in the public grooming tents and set up areas and must be maintained. The Fiesta Cluster Committee reserves the right to require that space in the Public Grooming tents be optimized and may require that crates be stacked. No vending may take place under any public grooming tent.

**Personal setups** (EZ-ups, canopy tents) are permitted in areas designated by the Fiesta Cluster. No setups will be permitted within 20 feet of any ring. No crates, exercise pens, grooming tables, or setups will be allowed in the aisles. The Fiesta Cluster Committee will make every effort to ensure that these policies are enforced and that setups are consolidated to accommodate as many exhibitors as possible in the Public Grooming Tents and the set up areas. Please note that some Specialty Clubs have reserved private tenting for their exclusive use. All public grooming tents will be clearly marked and may be used by all exhibitors. **THE CLUB IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR INJURY DUE TO TENTING NOT PROVIDED BY THE FIESTA CLUSTER. SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING RINGSIDE SHADE TENTS - RINGSIDE CRATING** The SHADED AREA at ringside is for the convenience of exhibitors while their breed is being exhibited. It is expected that exhibitors will occupy the shaded area no sooner than fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled exhibition time, nor any later than fifteen minutes after completion of their breed judging. **NO GROOMING, SETUPS OR EXERCISE PENS WILL BE PERMITTED AT RINGSIDE.** Dogs may not be left unattended in the shaded areas at RINGSIDE while that breed is currently being exhibited. The Show Committee will impound dogs left in violation of this regulation. Owners or agents who violate these regulations, or whose dogs have been impounded by the Show Committee will be subject to disciplinary action as exacted by the Show Committee of the Scottsdale Dog Fanciers Association, Inc. and/or Superstition Kennel Club, Inc. Expenses incurred thereof will be the responsibility of the owner.

### IMPORTANT

There are Bathrooms and Showers available for exhibitors located above the NE corner of the Polo Field. Any exhibitor found with a dog in bathrooms or showers will **NOT** be allowed to exhibit and will be subject to action by the SHOW COMMITTEE. A sanitary dump station is available on the grounds.

**GOLF CART USAGE DURING SHOW HOURS:** The **ONLY** carts allowed in the vicinity of the rings will be **OFFICIALLY MARKED FOR FIESTA CLUSTER COMMITTEE USE ONLY.** Private golf carts will be restricted to traffic on the outside perimeter of the Show Boundaries designated as the Fire Lanes.
